September is a special time in our family. Not only is it Linda's birthday (she turned 64), but that of her twin sister & her Mother. Yes her Mother had twins born on her birthday. Growing up many times there were 3 birthday cakes! This year is the 2nd year Linda as been the only one in her family celebrating a birthday. This has been a time of remembering, reflecting, and reevaluating.

With this in mind, we have decided to "slow down" a bit. We do not plan to retire; rather, we plan to focus on those water and sanitation projects that seem to have the most need and to do a bit less travel. We will still work as missionaries with The Mission Society as Water and Sanitation Specialists on the Global Resource Team. We will no longer be working full time (or receiving a full salary), so this will allow us a little more time to be grandparents, and participate in local church ministry.

Since we are essentially shifting to a "project based" ministry, we still need funds to pay for the water projects that we do abroad with our fellow missionaries, and to pay for the necessary travel. The projects will be very similar to that which we are currently helping with in Nicaragua. As you may remember,

the community of San Diego is well organized and needed a water well. The local missionary had raised about half of the funds needed for the well, and we were able to cover the remainder of the costs with donations to our ministry (cost of the well was about \$10,000 plus a pump). With our connections in Nicaragua, we lined up a driller and the well was recently completed.

This is the type of project we love—combining your funds, local funds, local labor & we do the coordination. The icing on the cake is going to the project site and dedicating the project to Jesus—that's what we are all about!

There are needs for these types of water projects in many parts of the world, and we have received requests from missionaries who need our help. So, we are asking you to continue your support of our ministry, but to cover project costs rather than our personal support. You will find donation information on the next page.

What's in store for us till the end of 2013? God only knows, but for now, grandson #4 due first of November, and our 44th anniversary is the end of November...
